GETTING STARTED

Three steps to a connected site

Unlock once, connect each site, then chat. Your first site is included in the unlock — no extra charge.

STEP 01

Unlock the agent

A one-time activation that never expires. Includes your first connected site.

STEP 02

Connect your site

Self-hosted WordPress with an Application Password, or WordPress.com with one-click OAuth. Credentials are stored encrypted.

1st site free +60 / extra site

STEP 03

Install the connector

One free plugin from the WordPress.org directory unlocks SEO metadata writes. The app shows a per-site banner until it's active.

THE CONNECTION

One plugin, drawn on purpose

The Raechal SEO Connector is how the agent writes real SEO fields to your site — title tags, meta descriptions, canonicals, Open Graph, robots directives and JSON-LD schema — through a dedicated, permission-checked channel.

What it lets Raechal do

Read and write only what an Editor could — nothing hidden.

What it won't touch

It stays in its own lane so your existing setup is safe.

› Leaves Yoast, Rank Math, AIOSEO and SEOPress fields

CAPABILITIES

What you can ask it to do

Talk to it like a teammate. Read-only work runs instantly; anything that changes your site asks first.

Audit the whole site

Find what's hurting rankings, across every post and page at once.

- › Missing meta, excerpts, featured images
- › Duplicate titles and slugs, thin content
- › Stale posts, broken headings, orphan pages
- › Sitemap coverage gaps

See what Google sees

Inspect the live, rendered page — not just the editor draft.

- › Live title, meta description, canonical, robots
- › Open Graph, Twitter cards and JSON-LD schema
- › Broken-link checks and response headers
- › robots.txt issues flagged in plain language

Fix it in place

Apply the fix and push it straight back to WordPress, with a dry-run preview when you want one.

- › Rewrite title tags and meta descriptions to length
- › Set canonical, OG, robots, schema / JSON-LD
- › Clean up slugs and excerpts
- › Replace or remove broken links

Handle media

Upload, caption and place images without leaving the chat.

- › Upload from a URL or generate from a description
- › Bulk-fix missing alt text (up to 100 at once)
- › Set featured images, insert images inline
- › Paste an image into chat — it uploads on send

Shape site structure

Tidy the architecture that helps both readers and crawlers.

- › Create categories and tags
- › Create redirects (with the Redirection plugin)
- › Inventory categories, tags and existing redirects

Create and publish posts

Spin up a new post — publish now, save a draft, or schedule it.

- › Draft, publish, pending or private status
- › Schedule a future publish date and time
- › Set categories, tags, slug and excerpt on create
- › Delete a post (Trash by default, recoverable)

AUTOBLOG POSTING

Blog Studio → live WordPress post

Write an article in Blog Studio, hit publish to WordPress, and the agent posts it for you — the exact draft, byte for byte, no truncation or rewriting.

1 · Hand off from Blog Studio

Send a finished article to the WordPress Agent. The handoff is detected on the server, so the post can never be billed or triggered by accident.

2 · Content is locked server-side

The saved article is injected directly — placeholder images stripped, the duplicate H1 removed, dashes normalised. The model never retypes the body, so nothing gets cut off.

3 · Styled to match your site

If you've set a design profile, the markdown is rendered to HTML using your site's learned styling, so the post looks native rather than pasted in.

4 · Published, drafted or scheduled

Go live now, save as a draft, or set a future date. You get back one line: the post ID, title and live link.

Nothing happens you didn't approve

It edits a real, public website — so it's wired to be cautious by default and reversible by design.

Every edit is reversible

Each change auto-saves a restore point — title, content, slug, meta and more. Roll any post back to a previous state in one click (up to 20 kept per post).

Deletes ask first, Trash by default

The agent shows the exact post and waits for your yes. Posts go to Trash, recoverable for around 30 days. Permanent deletion only on an explicit request, with a warning.

Bulk changes are previewed

Anything touching more than one item is planned out and shown for approval first, then run one at a time — capped at 50 per command.

Offline sites cost nothing

If your site can't be reached, the agent stops before charging — zero credits, and no made-up audit from stale data. If credentials are revoked, it tells you to reconnect.

CREDITS

What it costs

Pay with credits as you go. Access is lifetime once unlocked — no subscription on the WordPress Agent itself.

Unlock the WordPress Agent One time. Lifetime access. Your first site is included.	75 credits

GOOD TO KNOW

Where it draws the line

Honest boundaries, so nothing surprises you.

- Long-form writing lives in Blog Studio. The agent fixes SEO and metadata, but won't draft or expand body prose.
- The agent can delete posts, but not pages. Delete pages from WP Admin.
- It never edits third-party SEO plugin fields (Yoast, Rank Math...) — your existing values stay as they are.
- SEO meta fields are written through the connector plugin — so it needs to be installed and active.
- Image uploads work on self-hosted WordPress. WordPress.com media upload isn't supported.
- You acknowledge a one-time risk notice per site, since changes go live immediately.
